Summary of benefits

The Annual Meeting of SGG - SASL & SVEP is the largest professional event in the field of Gastroenterology and Hepatology in Switzerland.

For members of the organizing associations – as well as an opportunity for continuing professional education – it is an important platform for exchanging ideas with colleagues.

The industry exhibition is a major part of the Congress for participants.

The plan has been elaborated by the Congress Kursaal Interlaken together with the Congress President and the Congress Organization.

For the exhibition, the Congress President, Congress Organization and Congress Kursaal Interlaken have intensively considered a wide range of options also this year.

Also this year, the exhibition will take place in the very large **Kongresssaal**. All participants who want to get to the rooms in the northern part have to go through there, as the corridor next to it will be closed. A large catering station will be in the center of the room, and the poster exhibition will also take place there.

In the rooms in the northern part, we will offer in 2026 – exceptionally, in addition to the regular course in the first half of the year, a course for the use of Propofol in Gastroenterology. There are planned also courses in BLS-AED which form the practical part of the Propofol certificate.

You can enter your placement wishes **directly in the inscriptionsform** (Prio1/Prio2/Prio3). Be sure to select 3 different placements. **As always since many years, booth spaces and symposia are first come - first served.**

Gold, silver or bronze partners are “identified” according to their benefits and they are rewarded with a discount.

All gold, silver or bronze sponsors will be listed on the [congress website](#) with company logo, which is linked to the appropriate website.

All companies participating in the Congress are listed on the Congress-website, in the preprogram/flyer in spring (will be sent to all members of the organizing societies) as well as in the mainprogram.

As usual, the principle of **first come, first served** is applied; the time of your registration is decisive for all offered benefits. This principle will be applied up **15 February 2026**. However, it is also possible that the exhibition is fully booked before this deadline. After that date, all benefits, such as the symposia and the booths or advertisements, will be allocated by the Congress Organizer based on availability at the time.

Receipt of all registrations will be acknowledged by email (usually not more than 3 working days after receipt).

Guidelines for the Annual Meeting of the Swiss Society of Gastroenterology SGG, the Swiss Association for the Study of the Liver SASL and the Swiss Society of Endoscopy Nurses and Associates SVEP

The Annual Meeting, as the most important annual forum, offers industry and the medical profession an open platform to exchange experiences, to present new products and maintain customer relations. In order to ensure orderly running and mutually satisfactory cooperation between professional bodies and exhibitors, the following obligatory key points have been brought together in the form of guidelines.

1. Registration / Announcement

- An industry exhibition reflecting the importance of the event is being held. The SGG-SASL & SVEP-Congress **does not guarantee industry exclusivity** for the annual Congress. The potential exhibitors from trade and industry shall be approached by the Congress Organization well in advance. The announcement will be published at the same time on www.sggssg.ch
- gkaufmann Verbandsmanagement & Kongressorganisation, which is responsible for organizing the meeting (Congress Organizer), will publicize the dates of the Annual Meeting as early as possible, usually at least one year in advance (www.sggssg.ch – Events SGG) so that interested companies are able to make appropriate plans.

2. Layout/Size of booths

- The principle of **first-come, first served** generally applies to the selection of stand location (since 2012). The requests of gold, silver or bronze partners are given priority according to their financial contribution.
- The exhibition plan is already fixed. You can enter your preferences for placement in the form (Prio1/Prio2/Prio3).
- If there is any dispute regarding location/design of an exhibitor's booth, **the Congress President shall decide together with the Congress Organizer.**

3. Setting up and dismantling

- Congress participants shall find an exhibition that is set up and open at the start of the Congress (17.06.2026: 08h30).
- Therefore, it is imperative to set up the booth **the day before (16.09.2026, 07h00 – 20h00)**. To agree **an earlier set-up date, exhibitors must contact the Congress venue directly. Costs for this earlier set-up will be invoiced directly by CKI.**
- Later set-up is only possible in justified, approved exceptional circumstances and under no circumstances should it disrupt any of the Congress sessions (noise emission, etc.).
- The **dismantling is also in 2026 possible on Friday, 18.09.2026, from 16h00 to 22h00.**

4. Stand activities

- The booth shall be staffed in the morning at the start of the Congress, i.e. **not later than 09h00, and must not be closed before 18h 00** in the evening.
- **Expert presentations** or talks are not permitted on the booths.
The Congress-sessions begin at 08h30 on both days. Registration will be open from 07h30 on Thursday and 07h15 on Friday.

5. Stand staffing and closure

The individual booth shall be staffed throughout the Congress, i.e. from not later than 09h00 on day 1 until **16h00** on day 2 of the Congress.

6. Satellite symposia

- Satellite symposia may be held in the lunchtime break on both days of the Congress and before the Congress starts (early-bird) on the second day. **These must not interfere with the official Congress program.**
- Interested parties shall notify the Congress Organizer, stating the topic and the chairman of the parallel symposium, **not later than 15 February 2026**. The number of symposia is limited (4 lunchtime symposia each on both days and 2 early-bird symposia on day 2). Due to the strong demand we can give in a first round **only one symposia per company**. If after this first round there should be symposia left, those would be given to the companies that would perform more than one symposium.
- Slots will be allocated on the basis of first-come, first-served.
- **Reservations for future years cannot be made.**
- The satellite symposia will be mentioned in the preprogram/flyer, the main program and on the website, stating topic, speaker(s) if available.

- Organizers of symposia have to announce topic, chairman and speaker to the Congress organizer to the 15th of March 2026. Elapses this date without a relevant announcement, the claim for the symposia expires (latest announcement at the end of March 2026).

7. Social evening – Gala Dinner - Banquet

- The social evening is especially important.
- It helps to foster friendship, partners of Congress attendees are warmly welcome.
- During the social evening, prizes will be awarded. The winners having been judged by the Congress Scientific Committee.
- The companies are required not to hold any competing events on the same evening. Company representatives may attend the social evening on payment of a charge not more than 2 people from each company are permitted. **Tickets (CHF 150.00) can be ordered from the Congress Organization by mail (congress@sagssq.ch).**
- Company representatives may attend also the social evening of SVEP (Banquet). Tickets (CHF 85.00) can be ordered by mail: fabia.reichenbach@gkaufmann.ch. Not more than 2 people from each company are permitted.

8. Decision-makers

In case of dispute, the Congress Chairman shall decide together with the Congress Organizer.

These guidelines enter into force on 17th December 2025.
